INASAN and UCM are designated organizations by the International Agreements on WSO-UV mission (Ground Segment, Field Camera Unit and Time Sharing Policy) for the science operations of WSO-UV.

The JCUVA hosts the facilities required for conducting the WSO-UV science operations run by Russia and Spain. Its activities also comprise the joint management of the WSO-UV science program.
